# INTRODUCTION

## Purpose and Objectives

The Office of Travel and Tourism Industries (OTTI) is required to effectively provide travel data to public and private industry users. To fulfill this requirement, OTTI produces the *Summary of International Travelers to the United States*. The *Summary* is the official Federal government source for counting international arrivals to the United States.

The report defines the size, characteristics, and travel patterns of inbound international visitor arrivals coming to the U.S. from world regions and countries, by country of residence. These data are tabulated and published monthly by OTTI. There is no other source for this data.

## Methodology

This report integrates the volume of inbound international visitors to the United States from residents of other countries, using U.S. and international government sources. This report is based on three sources: the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) I-94 data, Statistics Canada's International Travel Survey (ITS) and Banco de Mexico travel estimates.

The count of **overseas** visitors to the United States is based on DHS I-94 Arrival/Departure Record data. For citizens from Visa Waiver Program countries, arrival record accounting is automated. Citizens from non-Visa Waiver Program countries are still required to complete the I-94 paper document before admittance to the United States. DHS provides OTTI the I-94 data on a monthly basis.

To account for visits (arrivals) to the United States, OTTI only selects I-94 records bearing certain visa types (see list below). Also, to comply with globally accepted international tourism definitions and classifications (United Nations World Tourism Organization/UNWTO), a traveler must spend one or more nights in the United States for a period that does not exceed 12 months in order to be classified a visitor to the United States. Also, the purpose of the trip must be for pleasure, business or study. In addition, all visitors are primarily recognized by residency rather than citizenship.

The count of Mexican visitors to the United States is based on monthly estimates from the Banco de Mexico. OTTI does use the DHS I-94 air only count to determine Mexican air travelers to the United States. The count of Canadian resident travelers to the United States is provided by Statistics Canada.

The Visa Waiver Pilot Program (VWPP) expired at midnight on the evening of April 30, 2000/morning of May 1, 2000. With the statutory expiration of the VWPP, the Department of Homeland Security, Office of Immigration Statistics began paroling into the United States for up to 90 days, under terms and conditions almost identical to those required under the VWPP, those travelers who otherwise would have been eligible for entry under the VWPP. These measures were undertaken in order to avoid substantial disruption to international travel and commerce.

A parolee is defined as an alien, appearing to be inadmissible to the inspecting officer (e.g., lack of a valid visa), allowed into the United States for urgent humanitarian reasons or when that alien's entry is determined to be for significant public benefit. Parole does not constitute a formal admission to the United States and confers temporary status only, requiring parolees to leave when the conditions supporting their parole cease to exist. Therefore, parolees are not classified as tourists or visitors for business or pleasure.

On October 30, 2000, the Visa Waiver Permanent Program Act made permanent the Visa Waiver Pilot Program. On October 31, 2000, the Department of Homeland Security, Office of Immigration Statistics resumed admitting visitors for business as WBs and visitors for pleasure as WTs. The permanent program permits nationals from participating countries to apply for admission to the United States for ninety (90) days or less as visitors for business or pleasure without first obtaining a nonimmigrant visa.

Due to this variance, annual comparisons are not available from 2000/2001 for tables D1 and D2 only. You will see the total arrival figures reported in this table to do not add up to the totals for the other tables within this report. Therefore, please use these tables with caution if they are used.

Other "non-tourist" visitor counts reported in the DHS I-94 form data, such as transiting visitors en route to another country destination and official diplomats, are excluded from the *Summary* report because they are not by definition considered as an international visitor to the United States.

Canadian Visitor Counts: Office of Travel and Tourism Industries relies on Statistics Canada's International Visitor Survey to provide monthly inbound visitors from Canada to the United States. The inbound arrivals from the survey are reported in the *Summary* but are subject to quarterly and annual revisions by Statistics Canada (please see the Limitation section below for more details.)

## Report Limitations

### Trend Line Analysis

A complex federal and private industry network endeavors to produce this report. Over time several system changes occurred due to this complex process of collecting, processing and reporting the visitor arrivals data for the US. System changes to select data make some elements of this data base incompatible with arrival statistics produced and reported in prior years. When using this report in a time series the user should pay close attention to past report introductions to assess comparability issues. Additionally, many official country designations change over time, which may effect time series analysis.

## Mexican Arrivals to the United States

Prior to 2010, the United States only reported monthly Mexican tourist arrivals who visited the U.S. 'interior', beyond the 40 kilometer-25 mile border zone. Starting in 2010, OTTI reports all Mexican travelers to the United States using estimates from Banco de Mexico. Air travel counts, however, are derived from DHS I-94 records .

## Canadian Arrivals

Data on Canadian arrivals are derived from Statistics Canada's International Travel Survey. OTTI uses Statistic Canada's data as the official visitor estimates. These data reflect the number of Canadian residents visiting the United States overnight or longer. The Canadian arrival data are subject to monthly, quarterly and yearly revisions. ## China/Peoples Republic of China (PRC) and Hong Kong

Starting in 1996, OTTI began reporting China PRC and Hong Kong as one country due to the re-unification. However, OTTI will continue to sub-set Hong Kong as long as Hong Kong residency data are reported by DHS. The Hong Kong data should be considered as an estimate in all years subsequent to 1996.

## First Intended Address of Non-Resident Arrivals by Country of Residence

Data found in First Intended Address of Non-Resident Arrivals by Country of Residence tables (tables G.1, G.2, H.1 and H.2) understate the total number of international travelers that visited any given state. Based upon two other Office of Travel and Tourism Industries research programs (In-Flight Survey and Pleasure Travel Market Study to North America), it is documented that Overseas and Mexican travelers (Mexican visitors to U.S. interior only) actually visit an average of nearly two states. This means that simply using the First Intended address would shortchange the state visitor total. Furthermore, within the first address data, there are a number of records in which no address is provided. This further under estimate visits to the states. state-level visitor estimates. OTTI feels that our In-Flight Survey program provides the best estimate for total visitation of international travel to the states and cities within the United States.

### **Revisions to the 2001-2002 Arrivals data**

Shortly after September 11, 2001, the DHS implemented a new policy in which all travelers to and through (transit travelers) were required to complete the I-94 form. With the addition of the transit travelers to the data base, the arrival counts were being over stated. To provide true arrival totals for visitors to the United States, the transit travelers must be taken out. OTTI worked with DHS to obtain the departures data so the transit passengers could be eliminated from the data base.

This process was completed for the September-December 2001 data and for all 12 months of the 2002 arrivals data. OTTI had issued preliminary data that included the transit passengers as we worked out the methodology to obtain the data and then eliminate the extra travelers added to the counts. The preliminary data has been pulled from the OTTI web site and only the revised final totals are reported. During this time,

OTTI stopped printing the monthly reports as no additional funds were provided to us to revise this data. To ensure you have the correct reports, please compare the arrival totals to what is published on our web site for September-December 2001. No 2002 reports were printed using the preliminary data, so all printed reports were based upon the revised data. For 2003, this methodology is still being used, but no preliminary data was ever released for 2003. The data for all of these years is comparable to past arrival reports.

OTTI still provides the only source of arrivals to the country, by country of residency using the I-94 database. This information provides a COUNT of the number of arrivals to the United States each month and is the best source available on determining the number of visitors to the country.
